On 01-17-09, a resident on Kelly Mill Road reported that two white males came to his home claiming to be with the government doing free work on the homes of elderly people. The victim said that when they came into his residence they brought in a large carpet which they unrolled and held up, blocking the victim's view of the hallway that connects the entrance of the residence to his bedroom. The victim said that the suspects said they were offering free floor coverings to better help insulate the homes and the large carpet was an example. The victim said that when they were finished talking, the suspects folded the carpet up and left the residence in a passenger car at a high rate of speed.

The victim later found that \$2000.00 had been stolen from a drawer in his bedroom.
