Within the past month the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office has received several reported incidents of autos being entered around the south end of the county. The evening of 11/6/08 several incidents of entering auto took place within the Shepherds Pond subdivision located off of Mullinax Rd. At approximately 2:00am a witness observed a suspicious vehicle driving within Shepherds Pond with its headlights blacked out. The vehicle was described as a late model maroon or red colored van. The witness stated that the van appeared to be "beat up" and its side door was open. The witness was unable to see the occupant (s).

The Forsyth County Sheriff's Office is very interested in locating this vehicle, in that it is believed that the subjects occupying the van may be responsible for several entering auto incidents over the past month.
