Several of us have received a circulating email regarding incidents in which a male and female approach a house in the evening hours alleging to sell carpet cleaning services or products. There have been no reports of any illegal activity other than violating Forsyth County's solicitation ordinance. Those soliciting door to door must have a badge issued by our Special Services Section displayed at all times and may not solicit door to door if a "No Solicitation" sign is posted either at the residence or at the entrance of the subdivision.

If anyone suspicious approaches your house, please contact law enforcement and *don't answer the door.*

Please remember to call 911 if you see suspicious activity, vehicles, or people.
